High Line

The High Line is a 1.45 mile-long New York City linear park built in Manhattan on an elevated section of a disused New York Central Railroad Spur called the West Side Line.

Chelsea Market

A block long and a block wide in the area of Manhattan known as the Meatpacking District, Chelsea Market has become in just fifteen years one of the greatest indoor food halls of the world, with more than thirty-five vendors purveying everything from soup to nuts, wine to coffee, cheese to cheesecake. Attracting 6 million national and international visitors annually, it is one of the most trafficked, and written-about, destinations of any kind in New York City.
